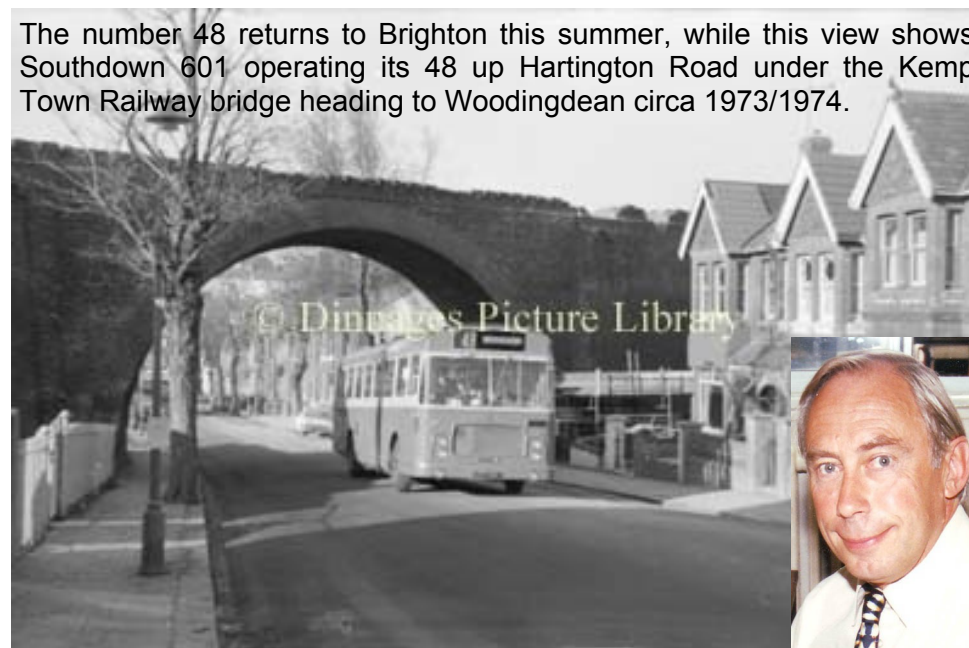
NEW VIEWS FROM JIM JONES & JACK TURLEY
